After the crisis in Idlib, under the leadership of the Republic of Turkey Ministry of Interior and the participation of NGOs, We carried out the construction of 2550 briquette houses in the region as part of the relief campaign started with the call of "We are together, We are with Idlib"

“Ramadan is the bond of communion”

Within Ramadan works, Aids were distributed to needy families living in 27 countries, especially Turkey.

Ramadan aids were carried out under the call of “Ramadan is the bond of communion” all around the world. Food packets, zakat, fitrah, packets for iftar, bread, and shopping cards were distributed to needy families and those affected by Covid-19.



Distribution of Zakat and Fitrah

We distributed zakat and fitrah to orphans, poor, and families affected by a coronavirus. Two thousand families benefited from the distributions.



Domestic Aids

We carried out Ramadan aids in 59 provinces of Turkey. Distribution of 3,500 Ramadan packets consisting of flour, pasta, rice, canned foods, salt, tea, sugar, and breakfast foods and 8,500 outreach cards were distributed to needy families. Our relief team presented eid clothes to 400 children. Pieces of Ramadan bread were distributed to approximately 20 thousand families.



Arakanese Refugees Were Happy

We did not forget Arakanese refugees, who fled the genocide and took refuge in neighboring Bangladesh. Distributions of Ramadan packets to 1050 families, eid clothes to 100 children, and zakat and fitrah to 200 families was carried out. The iftar tables did not set up due to Covid-19. Instead of this, we distributed iftar meals to two thousand people.



Syria Not Forgotten

Ramadan packets were distributed to 2,000 families living in Idlib and surrounding areas who spent Ramadan in the shadow of the war. Iftar meals were distributed to 1,500 people. A follow up the aids, 250 families in need were distributed fitrah and zakat.

Reliefs were carried out in 27 countries made the tables of the needy abundant.



21 Thousand Ramadan Packets

We carried out our aid works with the call of “Ramadan is the bond of communion” in the four corners of the earth. We made the needy families' tables abundant with the distribution of 21 thousand Ramadan packets.



Iftar For 15 Thousand People

Due to the coronavirus that has affected the whole world iftar tables weren't set up this year. Because of that, we distributed food packets to 15 thousand people's homes.



Ramadan Happiness in Yemen

With the civil war that began in Yemen in 2015, the humanitarian crisis is occurring on many issues, especially health, food, and education. During this Ramadan, food packets were distributed to 1,200 families in Yemen, iftar meals to 4,200 people, eid clothing to 120 children, and fitrah and zakat to 250 families.



Children Felt joyful of Eid

Our relief team gifted eid clothes to 1100 children living in Turkey, Yemen, Sri Lanka, Lebanon, and Bangladesh to feel the happiness of eid fully.

Our teams carried out the works in Turkey, Africa, Middle East, Central Asia, South Asia, Caucasus, Far East, and the Balkans.



Children Not Forgotten

3,000 children were gifted eid clothes and toys in 32 countries worked by our teams, volunteers, and partner organizations acting with ummah awareness in the Islamic geography.

Priority to War and Conflicts Zones

Within the qurban works, Priority was given to refugee camps, orphanages, schools, elderly, orphans, and zones, where occurred war, natural disasters, and poverty. As such, Syria, Iraq, Palestine, Somalia, Yemen, Bangladesh, and Arakan were prioritized.



30,000 People Aided in Turkey

While our domestic qurban works were carried out in ten provinces, 704 shares were slaughtered. Our qurban team shared the eid happiness by delivering the qurban shares to needy people identified.

“Let's Put A Smile On Their Faces”

Within Cataract Projects we initiated with the call of “Let's Put A Smile On Their Faces”, 1186 people were treated by surgeries performed in Sri Lanka and Mali.

1,186 cataract patients identified were operated in Mali's Sikasso and Sri Lanka's Puttalam regions.

A cataract that causes blindness if it is not treated is due to inadequate and unhealthy nutrition and head or eye traumas. In Africa and South Asia, many people lose their ability to see because of cataracts.

Under the control of our medical teams, 1,186 cataract patients were operated in Mali and Sri Lanka



900 Cataract Surgeries in Mali

Under the control of our medical teams and with the support of our donors, 900 cataract patients were operated in Mali's Sikasso region.

“Thousand of people are losing their ability to see due to cataract all around the world. To contribute to the solution of this problem, We operate cataract surgeries. We are happy because of contributing to the treatment of 900 cataract patients.” Said Recep Celik, member of Sadakatasi board, in a statement.



286 Cataract Surgeries in Sri Lanka

In the scope of Cataract Project in Sri Lanka, 286 needy cataract patients were treated, who have difficulty in seeing and doing daily routines.

The patients had been informed about the project with the announcements, which began 2 weeks before the surgeries,

that performed in Puttalam in January and February. Patients were identified by a sliding doctor team and were operated in hospitals.

Within the cataract projects, Approximately 4000 people were treated in Mali, Somalia, Ethiopia, Tanzania, Sri Lanka, and Pakistan since we established.

“A Water Well Full of Goodness”

750 million people, or about one-tenth of the world's population, do not have access to clean water. Poverty, drought, pollution, rapid population growth, global warming, and over-consumption are shortening the lives of clean water resources. Thousands of people die every year from diseases such as cata-racts, cholera, and diarrhea caused by the inability to use clean water.

If serious and sustainable measures are not taken to prevent the

reduction of clean water resources, the dangers facing people will increase even more. We are working to make millions of people around the world who have water shortage problems reach clean

drinking water. One of our water aids is water distributions and drill-ing water wells.

We contribute to the solution of droughtiness by performing water well openings in Asian and African countries where infrastructure systems are inadequate and people have difficulty in finding clean drinking water. With the support of our donors, the water wells, that we are drilling meet the most basic needs of people who live under difficult circumstances and cannot find clean drinking water.

Yemen Urgent Aid Continues

Within urgent aid works in Yemen, where is facing civil war, economic crises, and drought, thousands of families were distributed aid.

Within urgent aid works in Yemen, where is facing civil war, drought, epidemics, and death thousands of people, Food and hygiene packets, zakat, fitrah, qurban shares, and drinking water were distributed to families living in Hudaydah, Sana'a, Say'un, Taiz, Marib, Al-Ghaydah, and Aden.

23 Million People in Need of Help

Since the civil war began in Yemen in 2015, more than 70,000 people lost their lives. Attacks on hospitals, schools, and infrastructure facilities have become common. Epidemics are increasing day by day due to the lack of access to clean water, malnutrition, medicines, and medical supplies in the country, which is facing humanitarian crises in many fields, especially health. The country's 23 million people, about 75 percent of the population, live in need of humanitarian aid and protection.

Urgent Aid

In the scope of Yemen relief works in 2020, Distribution of food packets to 1500 families, pieces of bread to 50 thousand families, 71 tankers of drinking water, fitrah and zakat to 250 families, clothes to 800 people, 370 qurban shares, and hot meals to thousands of people was carried out. Also, the distribution of Tuk-tuk, which is used in freight and human transportation was made a great contribution to 5 families to revenue their own income.



166 Orphans Were Lent a Helping Hand

Thousands of children became orphans by the civil war. To contribute to the solution of this problem, the needs of 166 orphans living in Sana'a, Marib, and Ibb regions were met regularly. Also, Thousands of orphans have benefited from urgent aid carried to the country.



Adaq, Aqiqa and Shukr Qurbans

We sacrifice adaq, aqiqa and shukr qurbans that are donated during the year in the countries that we have determined at the end of each month. We deliver qurban shares to orphans in orphanages, refugee camps, and our needy brothers and sisters who are fighting for their lives around the world.

In 2020, we have delivered 4698 qurban shares to thousands of people in need.

With the arrival of the winter months in the Middle East, Caucasus and the Balkans we carried out winter aid works in needy regions.

With the arrival of winter months; refugees, homeless and needy people have had a hard times. Refugee camps, where hundreds of thousands of people are sheltering, are one of the areas, where have been experiencing this difficulty the most. We have carried out our 2020 winter aid works in our country and Islamic geographies in need. In countries where harsh winter conditions are experienced, we delivered blankets, scarves, berets, gloves, coats, boots, winter clothes, stoves, fuel, and food packets to our brothers and sisters in need.



Winter Aid to 6 Countries and Tens of Regions

Within winter aid works, Aid stuff such as winter clothes, boots, blankets, stoves, and fuel was distributed in Lebanon, Syria, Hungary, Kyrgyzstan, and Palestine, especially Turkey. Refugee camps, where hundreds of thousands of people are sheltering under difficult circumstances were prioritized.

“Income-Generating Projects”

Thanks to “Income-Generating Projects” we carry out in Bangladesh's Arakan refugee camps, Sri Lanka, and Yemen, the needy revenue income and acquire a profession.

We continue to support Rohingya refugees living in camps, Muslims living as minorities in Sri Lanka and Yemen, where is facing famine by “Income-Generating Project”, which provides jobs and economic returns.

Riksha used in human transportation, Van used freight transportation, and sewing machines for women were distributed to families living in refugee camps in Bangladesh to make them revenue their own income and contribute to the domestic economy.

Fishing boats in Sri Lanka and Tuk-Tuk used for transportation in Yemen were delivered to poor families.

Sewing Machine

Within the scope of Income Generating Project, 87 sewing machines were distributed which aims to support women by teaching them producing and selling textile products and contributing home economy



Riksha and Van

62 Riksha and Van used in human and freight transportation and designed in accordance with the geographical conditions were delivered to Arakanese families. Thanks to this project, Rohingya refugee families living under hard conditions in the region revenue their own income.



Fishing Boat

In Sri Lanka, an island nation, fishing has an important place for people in making a living. Fishing boats and the pieces of necessary equipment were delivered to 10 families to revenue their own income.



Tuk-Tuk Distribution in Yemen

Millions of people are living in need of help due to economic crises and famine that occurred after the civil war in Yemen. In order to make 5 families in need earn their livelihood, distribution of 3-wheeled, motorized Tuk-Tuk used in freight and human transportation were carried out.

Hundreds of thousands of children who have lost their families due to war, poverty, and natural disasters in the world are quite vulnerable. To contribute to solving this problem, We prepare orphans for the future with project we initiated with the call of " We Cannot Be Mothers or Fathers of Orphans But We Can Be Their Brothers And Sisters"



We Prepare Orphans For The Future

We conduct our orphan program in war zones, refugee camps and the regions where the effect of war continues. We primarily address the health and food needs of orphans in the unsafe environment of the war. We secure our orphans with financial and moral support by ensuring that their families survive, or they are transported to the safe environments we provide.

We protect orphan children in temporary shelters against all kinds of abuse in natural disaster areas and areas where they are needed. We meet the needs of the children until their survivors are found, and even if there are no survivors, we prepare orphanages and permanent shelters considering the demands of the local conditions and the regional structure.

With the support of philanthropists, we provide vocational qualifications to our orphans who have studied in orphanages and educational complexes we built

In addition to our orphans, which are regularly taken care of, hundreds of thousands of orphans were indirectly delivered aid with Ramadan, qurban, food packets, fitrah, zakat, hygiene, and urgent aid distributions that we carried out during the year.

Turkey Urgent Aid Works

After the earthquake in Izmir and Elazig and the floods in Giresun occurred in 2020, our relief teams arrived at crisis areas and carried out aid distributions and search and rescue activities.

After natural disasters such as earthquakes and floods in 2020, we carried out search and rescue activities and urgent relief works by our teams and delivered aid to our citizens.



Magnitude 6.6 earthquake in Izmir

The relief team of the Sadakatasi association moved to the region after the earthquake to provide urgent aid in the city of Izmir. Our team distributed hot meals, drink, and blankets and to those affected in the earthquake zone.

Flash Flood in Giresun

After the floods occurred in Dereli district of Giresun, our teams moved to the region for search and rescue activities and relief works. Within the scope of the aid, 680 electric torch and hot meal distributions were carried out.

Magnitude 6.8 earthquake in Elazig province

After the earthquake of 6.8 magnitudes, whose epicenter was the Sivrice district of Elazig and felt in the surrounding areas, our urgent relief teams moved to the region. Distribution of 1100 blankets, 90 stoves and diapers, milk and baby biscuits was carried out by our urgent teams to families affected by the earthquake and living in tents. Also, our volunteer doctors checked out the health of those affected by the earthquake



Sultan Abdulhamid Khan Mosque Opened For Worship

Sultan Abdulhamid Khan Mosque in Zanzibar, Tanzania, which we have projected to contribute to the solution of the problem of mosque shortages opened for worship.

With the support of philanthropists and under the leadership of our association, the problem of our brothers and sisters who had difficulty in finding a place for worship was addressed thanks to Sultan Abdulhamid Khan Mosque.

500 People Will Be Benefited

The mosque, which took 4 months to build, was built on an area of 156 square meters. 180 people can worship at the same time in the mosque with a fountain. 500 people living in the area will be benefited from the mosque.



Support to Andalusia Mosque

La Vega Mosque in Granada located Spain's Andalusia region was bought on credit by Muslims living in the region. The mosque association, which was unable to pay the installments due to financial impossibility, was provided with 92,000 euros in support.

The mosque, which has a total cost of 300,000 euros, was paid 150,000 euros by the mosque association. 65,000 euros of the remaining debt was paid by philanthropists from around the world. 92,000 euros were delivered to the mosque association by our association.

the mosque was rented by a company in the region in 2010 after the company considered renting a building and Zachariah who was the Imam of a mosque in Granada realized that the building that the company considered renting it, is a mosque. the mosque containing a hub for prayers, Qur'an education, celebrations, and cultural activities were put into service in 2011 after changing its interior design.

250 Muslims living in Atarfe where the mosque is located and residents in the surrounding areas benefit from the mosque. The mosque can not only play as a house of prayer but also use for Muslim' learning and cultural activities. Activities that make the mosque center of life such as Ramadan tables, celebrating Qurban together, slaughtering of Aqiqas, and wedding are carried out within the mosque.

Social Activities are Carried Out in the Mosque

From time to time workshops for groups of children and teenagers, sometimes lasting several days, on calligraphy, illumination, geometry, ceramics, archery, martial arts, and farming are carried out. Also, courses such as seerah, akhlaq, tasawwuf, tafsir, and psychotherapy are carried out in the mosque.

La Vega has a capacity for only 60 people, but 250 Muslims living in the region benefit from the mosque. with the Muslims living in surrounding areas come to the come, this situation makes imperative the mosque extended.



Moro Living Complex



The Moro Living Complex, which was designed to be built in the Philippines' Moro with a school, where 200 students will be educated at primary level, health clinic, mosque, and social areas, was projected.

The Kidapawan district of North Cotabato, where the Moro Training Complex was built, is located in the central parts of the island. The complex, which is projected on an area of 8,000 square meters, will consist of school and dormitories, administrative building, dining halls, mosque, health clinic, and social areas. Thousands of people living in the area will benefit from the complex.

Training center for 200 people

The project of the school where the children of poor families and orphans will be educated is continuing. 200 students will be educated at boarding school, which includes the religious and official curriculum. The complex also has sports arenas for students.

Mosque and health center in Moro

In order to solve the lack of houses of worship in the region, the project of the mosque where 300 people can worship at the same time is on-going.

Another major problem of the Kidapawan region is inadequate health services. In order to contribute to the solution of this problem, the construction of a health center with a capacity of 20 beds will be carried out within the living complex.

With the opening of the complex in Moro, important work on education, houses of worship, health, and social areas, which are the biggest problems of Muslims living in the region, will be put into service.



Berlin Sultan Ahmet Kindergarten in Sri Lanka

Kindergarten we projected with Berlin Sultan Ahmet Association was taken into service in Sri Lanka's Puttalam region.

The construction of the Berlin Sultan Ahmet Kindergarten, which was projected in the Puttalam region of Sri Lanka, was completed and opened for educational activities.

We continue our works to solve the education problem, which is one of the biggest problems of Muslims living as a minority in the region. Accordingly, 50 students will be studied at the kindergarten level in the school we built.

The project, built on an area of 120 square meters, took 9 months to build. In the kindergarten, which consists of two classrooms, an administrative office, and a children's park, students will be educated in the Islamic and official curriculum.



Musab Bin Umayr School in Tanzania



Musab Bin Umayr School we projected was taken into service in Kiyunga village Tanzania's Zanzibar region.

One of the biggest problems of Muslims living in Zanzibar is education. 180 students are studying at the primary school we built to contribute to the solution of this problem.

The project, built on an area of 360 square meters, took 6 months to build. The school consists of four classrooms, an administrative office,

and a children's park, and students are trained in Islamic and official curriculum.

Second Training Center in Zanzibar

With the construction of Musab Bin Umayr School, our second training center became operational in the region. 250 students are trained in the July 15 Martyrs Complex, which opened for education in 2017 and consisting of a library, computer room, classrooms, and Haci Osman Var mosque with a capacity of 350 people.



Support Palestinian Refugees in Lebanon

We are carrying out improvement and generating projects for Palestinian refugees living in the camps in Lebanon.

As Sadakataşı association, We initiated "Palestinian Camps Improvement and Generating Projects" to enhance Palestinian refugees' living conditions with the support of 22 NGOs. within the scope of the campaign, we have implemented illumination and distance learning projects at first.

Illumination Project

Burj Barajneh refugee camp, where Palestinian refugees live, is supplied electricity for just 5-6 hours a day. In many homes, electricity cannot be used due to insufficient infrastructure. In the first stage of the illumination project, the electric wiring of 5 houses was renewed and the solution of the electrical problem was provided.



Hakan Çakıl "I attach importance to these projects."

Lebanese Ambassador Hakan Çakıl made a statement that "I attach importance to these projects carried out by Sadakataşı Association. Due to some infrastructure shortages, not everyone may have access to distance learning from home. Therefore, distance learning from a center is done both much more efficiently and very easily. I would like to thank the Sadakataşı Association and its Lebanese partners."



Distance Learning Project

One of the biggest problems of Palestinian refugees living in Lebanon is education. We initiated distance learning project in the camps due to the spread pandemic across the world. The education was begun in the training center in Burj Barajneh by providing 40 laptops and its items, tables, chairs, and generator. Around 3,000 university and secondary students will benefit from the project, which will be completed as a returned education



Don't Leave Lebanon Alone

Following a large-scale explosion in the Lebanese capital, Beirut, our teams delivered food and hygiene packets, clothing, and urgent aid to the country throughout the year

Following the economic crisis, pandemic, political instability, and the explosion in the port of Beirut, humanitarian aid was delivered to Lebanon regularly throughout the year by our teams.



Food Aid

The explosion in the port of Beirut, the pandemic, and the economic crisis that has existed in the country for years have most affected those living in refugee camps. 2,000 food packets and 450 vegetable packets were distributed to families living in camps.

Thousand Bags of Flour

A thousand bags of flour were delivered to the region to solve the country's bread crisis because the 250-year-old Ottoman-era grain silo in the port of Beirut became unusable due to the explosion.

Urgent Aid

Within the scope of urgent aid, we delivered hot meals to more than 10,000 people, drinking water to 9,000 families, hygiene packets to 1,200 families, and pieces of bread to thousands of families. More than 50,000 people were aided in total. Also, 100 qurban shares were slaughtered and distributed to those in need.

Children Not Forgotten

250 children were gifted toys and clothes. Also, 500 baby packets consisting of food and hygiene products were distributed to families.

"Refugees who don't have got an opportunity to work officially and many of them living as dependent on foreign aids live in the hard-living conditions due to the pandemic. Urgent aid needs of the people are increasing from day to day by the reason of inadequate opportunities for coronavirus and unemployment. With this awareness, we will continue to support our refugee brothers and sisters with the aids we deliver to the entire country." Said Kemal Ozdal, chairman of Sadakatasi, in a statement.

Idlib Is Standing with Goodness

Urgent aid was delivered throughout the year to Idlib refugees who migrated to areas near our border due to the attacks. Permanent housing has been built to solve the sheltering crisis, which is the biggest problem of refugees.

In Idlib, where there was a great humanitarian plight, refugee families were regularly carried out to provide winter clothes, stoves, fuel, and packets of food, hygiene, and baby in 2020.



Winter Clothes Aid

Within the scope of urgent aid works carried out in the region, 11 thousand boots for children, thousand coats, 20 thousand blankets, and 500 thousand clothes were distributed to those in need.

Food Aid

Distribution of 170 tons of flour and two thousand food packets consisting of canned foods, tea, salt, pasta, rice, bulghur, oil, tomato pasta, milk, and baby biscuits was carried out.

The association used every means available to help Idlib refugees. Donations were delivered to those in need living in the region as food packets and bags of flour.



2550 Briquette Houses

In the scope of relief campaign initiated with the call of "we are together, we stand by Idlib" under the leadership of the ministry of the interior and participation of NGOs, We carried out the construction of briquette houses in the region.

In total, 2550 briquette houses with 24 square meters were completed and delivered to families in 13 different regions to solve the sheltering problem faced by Idlib refugees who fled the attacks and took refuge in areas close to the Turkish border. Also, Mosques, schools, and playgrounds were built in line with the needs of people in the region.



Support of Hygiene Products

We delivered hygiene packets to 1,500 families living in unhygienic conditions in camps where epidemics could appear.



100 Tons of Fuel and 1200 Stoves

1200 stoves and 100 tons of fuel were distributed to families in need to solve the stove and fuel problem, which is one of the most important necessities because of the harsh winter conditions in the region.



Distribution of Baby Packet

Children are most affected by the humanitarian plight in Idlib. 40 tons of milk and 500 baby packets consisting of shampoo, wet wipes, two packs of baby biscuits, and diapers were distributed to meet the need of children living in refugee camps.
